ADDENDUM NO. 1

**REQUEST TO QUALIFY - RTQ #43924 – TUNNELS E & F BETWEEN EXCHANGE PLACE AND
WORLD TRADE CENTER - INFRASTRUCTURE REPAIRS - CONTRACT PAT-650**

The Following changes are hereby made to the above RTQ:

- I. At the end of the last paragraph on Page 1, insert the following:
“The information security requirements are reviewed separately from the RTQ evaluation. Be advised, firms may not be able to receive bid documents unless they have met the requirements of the security screening, whether or not they receive a determination of qualification.”
- II. In Section III.A.1 make the following changes:
 - a. Delete the text of paragraph c) in its entirety and substitute therefor the following:
“The firm, or joint-venture, must utilize its own work forces to perform a minimum of 10% of the total scope of work as described in Paragraph II.”
 - b. Delete the text of paragraph e) in its entirety and substitute therefor the following:
“A firm may satisfy the experience requirements related to the prior performance of work described in Paragraph II above, through a proposed subcontractor identified in the RTQ response. Any such subcontractor will operate under the Respondent’s direct supervision, coordination and control. The qualification information for said subcontractor shall be submitted with the RTQ response. In the event of an award, the Contractor will be required to enter into a contract with each of the subcontractor(s) identified in this RTQ response, unless the Port Authority subsequently approves a substitute.”
- III. In Section IV.1 delete “Submissions will be accepted on an ongoing basis, until the bid due date” and substitute the following therefor:
“While this RTQ will remain open until the bid due date, it is recommended that Respondents submit their information in sufficient time so that the Authority receives it no later than 4:00 PM on March 7, 2017. Respondents submitting after this date may not be able to receive bid documents with sufficient time to prepare a bid.”
