Dear Sir or Madam:

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey hereby offers to amend the subject Request for Proposals (RFP), dated June 18, 2018, as follows:

In the Attachment A, page 8, section V. Commercial General Liability Insurance and Workers' Compensation Insurance Procured by Consultant, item 3. Professional Liability Insurance, second line, delete "\$50,000,000" and replace with "\$5,000,000".

In the Attachment A, page 8, section V. Commercial General Liability Insurance and Workers' Compensation Insurance Procured by Consultant, item 4. Commercial Crime Insurance, third line, delete "\$10,000,000" and replace with "\$1,000,000".

The following question was received from an RFP recipient. The question and the corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

Question 1: Will a proposal be considered responsive if, in lieu of completing Appendix A2, the proposer commits to identifying DBE partners and the associated percentage of spend upon task order award? To clarify, this commitment would be stated in an attachment to Appendix A2, on company letterhead and signed, but Appendix A2 itself would refer to the attachment and not be signed or notarized by the proposer. Appendices A1 and A4 would also be completed.

Answer: Following the award of the agreement as it is Task Order based, the Proposer will be required to submit completed and notarized Appendices A1, A2 and A4 for each task order issued under this agreement.

The due date for submittal of proposals remains Tuesday July 17th at 2:00 P.M.
