Dear Sir or Madam:

The following question is from an RFP recipient. The question and the corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

Question #1: In reference to the staffing analysis noted in the RFP Letter, Part III, Section F: Technical Approach, the work encompassed in the JFK International Airport Redevelopment Program will be further developed and may vary greatly in scope and complexity throughout the planning process, making it difficult to estimate the staffing needs and level of support at this time. Can the Authority provide any additional clarification (high level program schedule, size of program elements, etc) on which the staffing analysis can be based?

Answer #1: The work load is anticipated to be an FTE to each evolving project. The Project Manager is needed to assist in that process. The 10-year Capital Plan includes \$1 billion of investment in JFK Redevelopment. It is these projects that the selected Project Manager will manage.

The date for receipt of proposals for the subject RFP remains 2:00 P.M. on October 2, 2017.
